Pavilion

The Turks had to delay their proposed works to the ground floor changing room and don't yet have alternative dates. The Clerk will continue to work towards obtaining a

report on the structural integrity of the pavilion. The upstairs showers previously used by officials and visitors have now been out of use for over six months due to leaks. The Chairman proposed using current budgeted maintenance money to mend these showers. This was discussed with various suggestions made – installing a power shower, hiring temporary showers, having the structural survey done before taking a decision on the showers.

Fordingbridge Festival

A meeting will be held at the Town Hall on Wednesday 24th January 2018 with the aim of forming an events committee to run the Fordingbridge Festival. The Chairman mentioned the potential for damage to the pitches if heavy horses were involved and also to Brownsey's land if this were used as a car park.

Pitch Maintenance

The pitches are currently in very good condition. Out of season friendly games need to be limited as the grass needs time to recover. The Chairman proposed a formal closed season and will discuss dates with the Clerk. Cllr Perkins asked if a closed season would also exclude training sessions. The Chairman advised that training can still happen without the goal mouths being used.
